The Passover holiday celebrates the emancipation of the Jewish people from slavery led by Moses.

In keeping with the tradition of the holiday, bread will not be served at Greenwood House during the eight days of Passover. Food that is made with wheat, barley, rye, spelt or oats will not be offered unless labeled “kosher for Passover.”

In preparation for the upcoming holiday, all resident rooms will be cleaned and any non-kosher for Passover food will be bagged, marked and stored in designated storage areas. Please remember, only kosher for Passover food will be allowed in the building during this holiday.
